
## **Amusements for all...**

# Fairy Bridges & Wishing Chair

Travelling from South to North, Bundoran's Tullan Strand is proud to be the first Discovery Point you will meet in County Donegal on the Wild Atlantic Way, and what a place to start! With 360 degrees scenic views you can see Mullaghmore Head, County Sligo and across Donegal Bay to the magical Sliabh Liag Cliffs. As you begin the Rougey Walk Experience, you will arrive at the stunning Fairy Bridges – sea stacks thousands of years old and Bundoran's original tourist attraction back in the 1800s. However, as far back as the 1700s locals thought these were haunted by the faeries which gave them their name "The Fairy Bridges".

While you're there, take a seat on Bundoran's own Wishing Chair. It is said that over the years many of the town's famous visitors have sat here overlooking the wild Atlantic Ocean including poet William Allingham, golfer Christy O'Connor, Viscount Enniskillen and 10 times world champion surfer Kelly Slater.

Legend says it is advised to approach the chair with caution lest the powers of the chair be disrupted. Wishers are meant to sit down slowly holding on to both “arms” of the chair, then pause for at least 15 seconds to take in the stunning scenery of Donegal Bay and Tullan Strand, with the Dartry Mountains as a spectacular background. Here you can contemplate the heroes and heroines who may have sat in the chair in times gone by, before making your wish which must be done in silence and kept private in order to increase the chances of it coming true. It is believed as you get up you should tap the seat twice to commit that your wish is a genuine one.

# Surf Capital

What truly sets Bundoran apart from other surfing destinations is the wide variety of waves available for all levels, all within a short distance of the town. From Tullan Strand and Main Beach to the famous Peak, and nearby beaches such as Rossnowlagh and Streedagh, Bundoran offers year-round surfing in a spectacular Atlantic setting.

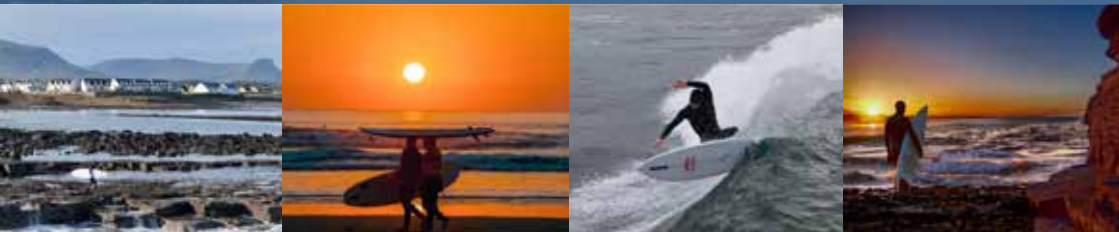
**Beginners & improver** - For beginners or those who have only surfed a handful of times, we strongly recommend taking a lesson with one of Bundoran's excellent surf schools. All schools are approved by the **Irish Surfing Association**, and just as a beginner skier wouldn't start on a black run, learning with experienced instructors ensures a safe, fun and confidence-building introduction to the sport. Qualified coaches and lifeguards will assess conditions and bring you to the most suitable beach on the day. **Tullan Strand and Rossnowlagh** are widely regarded as the best beaches for learning to surf, offering space, consistency and forgiving conditions.

**Intermediate** - Whether you're renting equipment or travelling with your own board, Bundoran's surf schools are always happy to offer advice. Boards and wetsuits are widely available, and local knowledge is invaluable - surfers are strongly encouraged to seek advice before entering the water. Tullan Strand is famous for being considered **Ireland's most consistent beach break**, with waves breaking along the length of its golden sands and something to suit almost every ability. When conditions become too powerful at Tullan, many surfers head to **Rossnowlagh or Streedagh**, where the waves are often smaller and more manageable.

**Advanced** - Bundoran's reputation on the international surf scene is built on **The Peak** and other nearby reef breaks. It's no coincidence that the town has hosted numerous Irish and international competitions over the years. With world-class waves and a welcoming surf community, Bundoran has attracted many of the world's best surfers, including **Kelly Slater** and **Mick Fanning**. These breaks are suitable for **very experienced surfers only**.

**Tow-In & Big Wave Surfing** - In 2020, local surfer **Conor Maguire** rode the largest wave ever surfed on the west coast of Ireland. Nearby **Mullaghmore** has since gained international attention as a big wave surfing destination. This extreme form of surfing is strictly for trained professionals, but it's an incredible spectacle to witness when conditions align.

**Inclusive Surfing** - For those who would like to experience surfing but face additional barriers, **Liquid Therapy** provides inclusive and accessible surf programmes. This inspiring surf foundation enables people of all abilities to enjoy the ocean in a safe and supportive environment. Find out more at [www.liquidtherapy.ie](http://www.liquidtherapy.ie)

The town is home to several nationally recognised food businesses, including **Madden's Bridge Bar**, a family-friendly pub and restaurant celebrated for its fresh, high-quality food.

A winner of Best Food Pub in the Region at the Irish Pub Awards 2025, Madden's also features in Lucinda O'Sullivan's Great Places to Stay & Eat for the eighth consecutive year.

For casual dining and a great night out, Bundoran's pubs play a central role in town life. **The Chasin' Bull** combines quality food with a lively bar atmosphere, while 51 Main Street offers the perfect spot to enjoy a pint by the fire in relaxed surroundings.

The **Railway Bar** is known for bringing together good pints, good company and plenty of craic, all year round.

The town's offering continues to grow, with the arrival of **Stoked** in 2026, adding a fresh and exciting new option to Bundoran's food scene.

Across the town, visitors can enjoy a wide variety of cuisines including Indian, Chinese, Italian, fresh seafood and artisan pizzas. Many venues are family-friendly, while others come alive in the evenings with live music sessions and entertainment, making Bundoran a great place to eat, drink and soak up the atmosphere.

Local produce plays an important role in many kitchens, with chefs supporting nearby suppliers such as Bundoran Community Garden and **Frizzell's Craft Butchers**, members of the Support Your Local Butcher initiative. Homemade baking is also a speciality in several cafés, with freshly baked breads, scones and cakes prepared daily.

Whether you're enjoying a relaxed lunch, an evening meal, live music or a quiet pint, Bundoran offers food and drink experiences that are as memorable as the setting itself. Into your craft beer? **Donegal Blonde** is brewed just 6km away in Ballyshannon, make sure to check out their tour.

# Getting About



Once you're here, there's lots of different options for getting about the area.

## Walking

Walking is the most obvious one. While Bundoran is a long town it's still quite compact and easy to get around with everything within walking distance. You can access our two cliff walks very easily and enjoy the fabulous views of Donegal Bay from both

## Taxi

A number of local taxi services will run you home at the end of a night out, drop you from one end of town to the other, to the bus station or even to the airport. Certain taxis can also be privately booked to bring you on a personalised tour of the region.

## Cycling

Bundoran is on the Euro Velo 1 route and has a number of signposted cycle routes as part of the Northwest Trail. If you haven't brought your own bike though don't worry! Bicycles (both push and electric) can be hired right here in town at Murfs Surf School. The friendly and knowledgeable staff will be happy to advise you on some local scenic routes to try out.

## Bus

Bundoran is well served with many bus routes including those provided by Bus Eireann, Ulsterbus, Local Link and Feda O'Donnell (Bus Feda). Local Link operates regular services between Kinlough, Ballyshannon & Sligo while Bus Feda operates twice daily to Galway and Gweedore. For connections to Dublin Airport and Dublin City Centre, Bus Eireann's Route 30 service from Ballyshannon offers a choice of 13 departures daily. Ulsterbus operates a Bundoran to Enniskillen service 6 days per week all year round while route 64 from Bus Eireann will bring you to Derry or Galway up to 5 times per day. Senior passes are accepted on all bus services.

## Bus Stops

Local Link stops at the Tourist Office and East & West Bus Stops. Bus Feda stops at the Tourist Office/Holyrood Hotel. Ulsterbus stops at Astoria Road and all Bus Eireann services stop at East & West Bus Stops.

# Must see...

## Places to visit



Setting up a base in Bundoran puts you in a perfect position to access spectacular attractions in Donegal, Leitrim and Sligo.



Just 6km away, Ballyshannon is Ireland's Oldest Town and is steeped in culture and heritage. It's also the birthplace of world famous guitarist Rory Gallagher, the home of poet William Allingham and the mother of Bram Stoker - author of Dracula!! Check out Ballyshannon museum, Campview Farm and Castle Adventure Open Farm for some family friendly activities.

For a great day trip from Bundoran why not pack the picnic basket and head south to the Gleniff Horseshoe in North Sligo. The horseshoe is a 9km drive around a valley ringed by Tievebaun, Truskmore, The Hills of AnnaCoona and Benwisquin mountains and home to Diarmuid and Grainne's Cave. Whether you drive it or walk it, it's one not to miss.



Further towards Sligo is Glencar Waterfall, which inspired some of poet W.B Yeats' finest work. Close by is the Sruth in Aghaidh An Aird (The Devil's Chimney) - Ireland's tallest waterfall with some nice walking trails too. Mullaghmore is another of the signature discovery points on the Wild Atlantic Way and shouldn't be missed.

**GO START  
EXPLORING**

A trip to Donegal Town isn't complete without taking in three of its top attractions – Donegal Castle, The Railway Heritage Centre and the Donegal Bay Waterbus. Cruise around Donegal Bay in the 160 seat Waterbus.

Donegal Castle is nestled right in the heart of Donegal Town. Built by the O'Donnell chieftains in the 15th Century, the castle stands beside the river Eske and was rebuilt in Jacobean style by Sir Basil Brooke in the 16th Century. Guided tours are available. And for the railway enthusiast, the Donegal Railway Heritage Museum is also a must.



You can also travel into Northern Ireland and take in the wonderful Marble Arch Caves (49km from Bundoran). Visitors are guided through a fascinating natural underworld while stunningly beautiful cave formations glisten all around. Nearby is the famous “Stairway to Heaven” boardwalk at Cuilcagh mountain. Spectacular views await climbers when they follow the Legnabrocky trail to the summit – the highest point of both counties Fermanagh and Cavan at 665m elevation.

Just a short drive from Bundoran is Belleek Pottery, one of Northern Ireland's most popular visitor attractions. While there take a trip to see the Magho View Point which provides an expansive vista across Lough Erne.

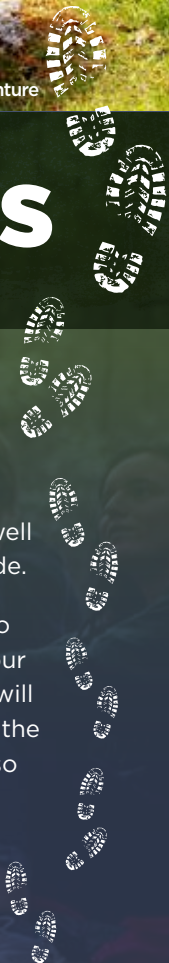
# Great outdoors

Being at one with nature is a priority for many and from coastal walks to mountain walks to sea and lake kayaking and more, the options are plenty!

## We have it all...

Coastal and Countryside Walks – Bundoran is home to the famous Roguey Cliff Walk and the equally stunning West End Cliff Walk as well as numerous routes that weave in and out of the adjacent countryside.

**Walks & Hikes** - Not only has it got a spectacular waterfall, you'll also find a waymarked mountain walk at Glencar, County Leitrim. Park your car at the waterfall and follow the nearby "bog road" upwards. This will offer panoramic views of Glencar Lake as well as unrivalled views of the nearby Sruth In Aghaidh An Aird (Devil's Chimney Waterfall) that also offers a walking trail.





**On Your Bike** – If two wheels appeals more than two feet, then bicycles (push and electric) can be hired in town (Murfs Surf School) and you can set off on an exploration of the locality from Ireland's oldest town (Ballyshannon), to Donegal Town and if you're feeling energetic enough, onto Killybegs and Sliabh Liag. In other directions, the Lough Melvin

loop will bring you along the shores of the famous fishing lake which straddles counties Leitrim, Fermanagh and Donegal. Further south, tackling the Gleniff Horseshoe loop and Mullaghmore Head will guarantee a good night's sleep!

If you want to take to the water and you're not a surfer, why not try a kayak session in the bay and around Aughrus Point towards Tullan Strand with Donegal Bay Adventure.

**Sea Swimming** - If swimming in the Wild Atlantic doesn't appeal to you, then how about the next best thing? Bundoran boasts two outdoor manmade seawater pools which are used all year round by both recreational and amateur swimmers – some practicing their lengths, others practicing ice swimming! Trained and experienced guides also offer mountain walks in the area.



Did you know you can sometimes see the Northern Lights in Bundoran? When conditions are just right, the spectacular Aurora Borealis dances across the sky over the bay, a magical sight that makes a night-time stroll along the shore even more unforgettable.

Music has long been part of Bundoran's heritage, with the dancehall tradition continuing to thrive alongside a vibrant live music scene. Ireland's top country and up-and-coming artists regularly perform at venues such as the Allingham Arms, while pubs across the town host live music throughout the summer and beyond. Traditional music fans can enjoy regular sessions, while jazz, folk and contemporary music also feature across different venues, ensuring a varied and lively atmosphere year-round.

The year begins with **Atlantic Fest**, bringing energy and activity to the town in January. **Féile na mBan**, held over St Brigid's Bank Holiday weekend in February, celebrates creativity, culture and community through a diverse programme of events. As the year continues, new festivals and events are introduced annually, adding fresh experiences for returning visitors.

September sees the return of the **SaltWater Festival**, which celebrates surf culture, coastal life and music, and in 2026 will host **European Junior Surf Championships (Eurosurf)**, welcoming competitors and supporters from across Europe.

This spectacular cliff-top links course is set on a rugged headland jutting out into Donegal Bay, directly along the **Wild Atlantic Way**. With the magnificent Dartry Mountains as a backdrop and panoramic views of the Atlantic Ocean, the course offers a memorable experience for golfers of all levels. When the Atlantic winds blow, the challenge is heightened, making every round both rewarding and unforgettable.

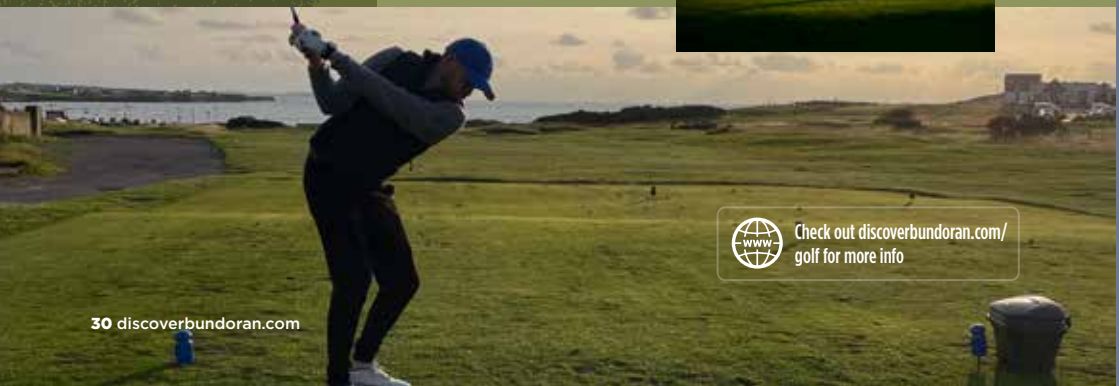
One of the highlights of the course is the **signature 11th hole**, which runs alongside the Wild Atlantic Way, offering breathtaking coastal views and a true sense of playing golf on the edge of the Atlantic. It perfectly captures the drama and beauty that make Bundoran Golf Club so distinctive. Surrounding the course, locals and visitors alike enjoy the famous Roguey Cliff Walk, stopping at the Fairy Bridges, while surfers can often be seen riding the waves at The Peak and Tullan Strand. It's not uncommon to spot marine life such as dolphins and seals along this stunning stretch of coastline.

Designed by **Harry Vardon**, the 18-hole course reflects his philosophy "to give pleasure to golfers of all degrees," combining playability with challenge in a truly scenic setting. Visitors are assured of a warm welcome both on and off the course. Bundoran Golf Club is a joint host of the **West Coast Challenge** and offers excellent facilities including a practice area, putting green, bar, restaurant and Pro Shop.

## Get Hooked...

In the town itself we are lucky enough to have some of the best shore angling marks in the country. Tullan Strand and the town's main beach both offer first class fishing for Flounder, Turbot, Seatrout and Ray to name just a few species, with rock marks at Rougey and the town's West End providing plenty of action with Pollock, Wrasse, Conger and Cod and much more.

Being on the wild Atlantic coast the boat angling is as good as anywhere in the world, literally anything is possible! During recent fishing seasons over 50 species of fish were landed by the local charter boats. In summer months the rich Atlantic waters are teeming with feed which creates a very diverse fish population.

Whether you would just like an evening mackerel and pollock fishing or to go for the fish of a lifetime such as shark, skate or even bluefin tuna, Bundoran has it to offer. For the game angler there is nowhere better. 3 miles south of Bundoran we have the fantastic Lough Melvin which offers world class fly-fishing for wild brown trout and salmon.

**Lough Melvin** is famous all over the world for its unique species of trout which are the beautiful gold bellied Gillaroo and the hard fighting black Sonaghan.

The **River Drowes** is a well-known river for its prolific run of wild Atlantic salmon. Nearly every year the first salmon in Ireland is caught on this small and beautiful water. Another 4 miles west of the town is the Bunduff River. This river also has a great run of salmon and offers great sport in July, August and September.

Just northeast of Bundoran at the end of a refreshing walk across the fantastic Tullan Strand you will find the famous Erne Estuary. This is without doubt one of the finest, if not the finest, seatrout fishing areas in Ireland. Finally, within 5 miles of the town we have numerous lakes for pike and coarse angling.

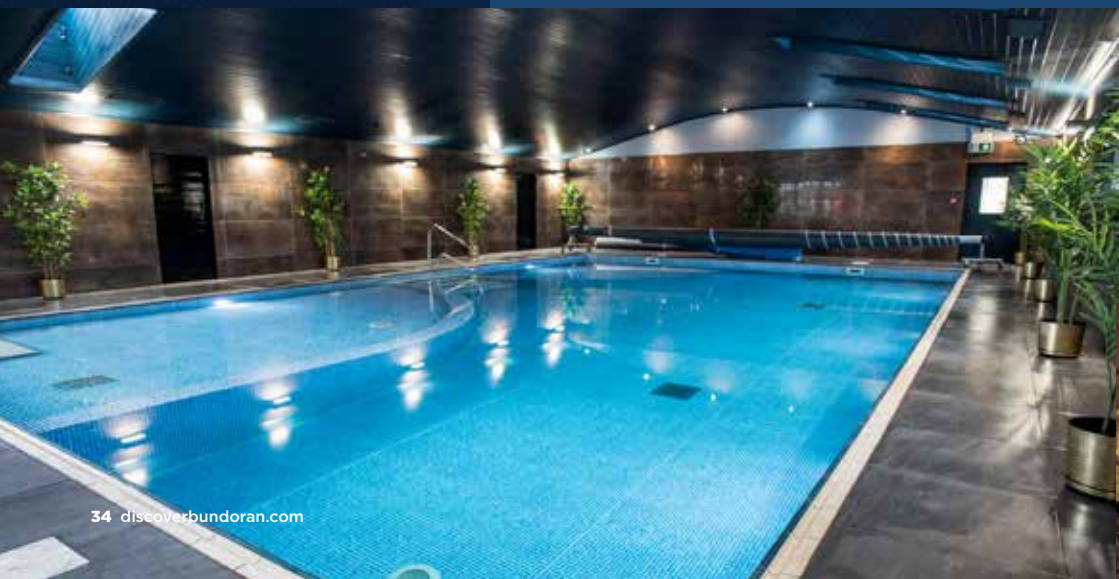

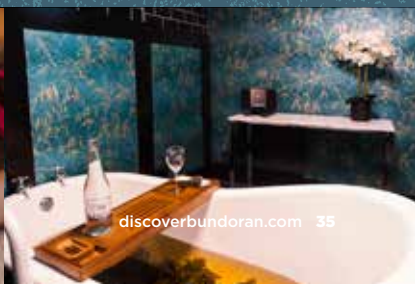

# Road Trip

## Discover Donegal

There are lots of great road trips to take, using Bundoran as a base.

### Travelling The County - Malin Head

150km from Bundoran is Ireland's most northerly point and was one of the filming locations for Star Wars - The Last Jedi. It's one of the three Donegal signature points on the Wild Atlantic Way and a must see part of the county! While you're there, check out the Inishowen 100 Drive, get your picture taken with an Alpaca on the Wild Alpaca Way, play a round at Ballyliffin Golf Club (home of the 2018 Dubai Duty Free Irish Open) and learn about the Flight of the Earls at Fort Dunree.

From Malin Head to Donegal Castle take a road trip through our beautiful County

## The lighthouse at Fanad Head

118km from Bundoran is one of the 12 Great Lighthouses of Ireland which guards the entrance to Lough Swilly. It is one of the 70 operational lighthouses under the control of the Commissioners of Irish Lights around the coast of Ireland. Tours offer visitors an unforgettable maritime adventure of lighthouse history and heritage. The Doagh Famine Village is also a must see in this area.

## Glenveagh National Park

It is the second largest national park in Ireland and is just 93km from Bundoran via Letterkenny. At the centre of the Park on the edge of Lough Veagh is Glenveagh Castle, a late 19th century castellated mansion, built as a hunting lodge in the heart of the Derryveagh Mountains. Mount Errigal and the Poisoned Glen are close by, and should also be on your photo bucket list!

## Sliabh Liag

Just across the bay from Bundoran (81km) lies the majestic Sliabh Liag. Said to be Europe's highest accessible sea cliffs, this is a walker's paradise. For the adventurous check out the pilgrim's path and one man's pass (not for the faint hearted). Make a day of it and visit the Silver Strand at Malinbeg, drop into Glencolmcille Folk Village, drive the spectacular Glengesh Pass to Ardara, and stop for some fresh sea food in Ireland's largest fishing ports, Killybegs, on the way home!

## Oakfield Park

The epitome of hidden gems in East Donegal, Oakfield Park is a privately owned estate and railway, which has won several National awards for the restoration of its gardens and buildings. Sitting in a lush landscape of parklands, lakes, mature woodlands, overlooking the distant Croaghan Mountain, the grounds include a hedge maze, sculpture and miles of walking paths.
